The Peer Services Project (PSP) program is a unique opportunity to get support, guidance, and training on topics that support self-sufficiency and independence.

Services include:

- Trainings and support for self-advocacy
- Information and support on reasonable accommodations
- Understanding your rights and responsibilities in employment
- Transportation coordination
- Plan for achieving self-support (PASS) development
- Support with Medicaid Buy In (MBI) application
- Information on health care self-management
- Pre-Employment Transition Services including job exploration, counseling, and workplace readiness training

All services are provided by Peer Independent Living Specialists, who are trained in the above topics and work with ACCES-VR and other providers to help you achieve your goals.
