The Administration for Children's Services (ACS) protects and promotes safety and well-being of New York City's children and families by providing child welfare, juvenile justice, and early care and education services.

In juvenile justice, ACS manages and funds services including detention and placement, intensive community-based alternatives for youth, and support services for families.

In child welfare, ACS contracts with private nonprofit organizations to support and stabilize families at risk of a crisis through preventive services, and provides foster care services for children not able to safely remain at home.

Child Protective Specialists (CPS) respond directly to reports of child abuse and/or neglect. Using investigatory and social work skills, they engage and partner with families and community resources to ensure the safety and well-being of children throughout New York City.

REQUIREMENTS

- A baccalaureate degree from an accredited college.
- Candidates must pass a test to demonstrate English language proficiency.
- New York City residency is not required.

BENEFITS

- A competitive salary of \$58,984. After successful completion of 6 months of service, you are automatically promoted to CPS Level II, with a base salary increase of \$64,059.
- 6 weeks paid training
- Overtime earnings and a night differential for certain assignments.
- Participation in NYC's pension system.
- Comprehensive health insurance offering both individual and family coverage
- The Mayor's Graduate Scholarship Program
- Public Service Loan Forgiveness
