## WORKING AS A SPECIAL OFFICER

Starting salary is \$39,206 and rises to approximately \$56,508 after five years

Yearly Uniform allowances of \$1,500

Special Officers assigned to Secure Detention receive an additional \$921 pay differential and a \$2,500 bonus available

Participation in NYC's pension system

Overtime pays at time and a half for working over 40 hours a week

Longevity Bonuses available after 15 years of service

### Requirements:

English fluency, a four year high school diploma or its educational equivalent approved by a state's department of education or a recognized accrediting organization. Individuals serving in this title are designated as Peace Officers by the New York State Criminal Procedure Law. Therefore, all candidates must be qualified to serve as Peace Officers and must satisfy the training made available by ACS for this position, as required by the State of New York. Once obtained, Peace Officer certification must be maintained for the duration of employment.

## What are we looking for?

We seek compassionate, dedicated, adaptable individuals to promote safety across all our agency sites. Working as a Special Officer, you would:

Provide physical security, safety, loss prevention, and maintenance of order

Screen staff, visitors, and vendors for prohibited items to ensure a safe site

Patrol city agencies, public buildings and facilities, and surrounding areas by making rounds, observing security monitors, and monitoring checkpoints

Operate, monitor, and maintain accountability for security equipment, conduct inventory checks and coordinate repair requests for equipment needing maintenance

Respond to incidents involving youth to help re-establish safety and good order
