## THE PII PROGRAM: TRAIN & EARN MODEL

### About Train & Earn

Train & Earn is a career pathways program that provides comprehensive job training and employment services, along with support services needed by participants to find a permanent job. The PII Program's new Train & Earn track will offer a clerical credential and a pathway to government-sector careers.

### PII's Train & Earn Track

- STEP 1** Earn your **Microsoft Specialist** credential in an 8-week clerical training program
- STEP 2** Complete a paid internship at at **NYC government agency**
- STEP 3** Work with AHRC NYC and the PII Program to **kickstart your career** in the public sector

### About the PII Program

The PII Program seeks to increase diversity and inclusion within New York government agencies by partnering with the City of New York and New York State to create internship opportunities for people with disabilities.



## Eligibility

This program is for youth 16-24 years old, not attending or enrolled in school, AND

- has a disability, or
- is a youth who received HS Diploma/equivalent and is low-income or an ELL, or
- requires additional assistance to complete an educational program, or to secure and hold employment (must also meet low-income definition)\*
